### Winemaking

Manual harvest in the last decade of August, with careful selection of the bunches in the field. Brief maceration and soft pressing of the grapes.

Alcoholic fermentation in a tank with controlled temperature (15° - 18°C). An additional 3 months of bottle aging for the final refinement.

Alcohol: 13% vol Sugar: 2.5 q/L Acidity: 6.60 g/L

Manduria, with its Magna Graecia heritage, becomes the heart of the story: a land that 'speaks' through its wine, rich in winemaking traditions rooted in a remote past. Femì embodies this ancient voice, reinterpreting it in a modern key to celebrate women and the connection to a generous and feminine land.

Femininity, strength, and connection to the land are the guiding threads of Femì, a wine that honors the history of Manduria while paving the way for a contemporary narrative.
